LOCATION

We are currently located near Maximum Gymnastics & Coulson Tough Elementary. We are a home studio and address will be provided upon signing up.

We offer both IN-PERSON & ONLINE lessons. Parents are welcome to sit in lessons as we understand not every child is comfortable with one-on-one. Parents may also wait in our waiting area accompanied by our own Corgi mascots that will be happy to keep you any guest entertained.

LESSON FORMAT

The first lesson will include a discussion to decide which direction you and your musician would like to go. If lessons begin and there is something you would like to learn do not hesitate to tell your teacher.

Our goal is not only to learn varying styles of music but build life skills. Styles and concepts vary from classical, standard public school repertoire, musical theater, fiddle, improvisation, contemporary/traditional church music, and music theory.

STOPPING LESSONS

If you need to stop lessons at any point please provide the studio a two-week notice. This is to allow teachers to transition your musician out of lessons in a way where they may keep their new found musical skills and to ensure every teachers time is respected.

LONG ABSENCES

If you need to miss an extended period of time, please let us know 2-weeks in advance. Your time slot will be held for a MAX of one month (i.e. four weeks) after that point you may resume your spot or it will be opened to new students.

MAKEUPS & MISSING LESSONS

Student Absence

You must contact the studio at least 1-week in advance to ensure a makeup lesson which will be scheduled for a later day/time. If you contact your teacher after this point you are not guaranteed a makeup and will not receive a refund. We will do our best to find a makeup time with 1-week notice but cannot guarantee a time will be available. We do not offer makeup lessons with less than 24-hour notice.

Teacher Absence

If a teacher must miss they will provide us a list of available times for makeup lessons, or we will provide a qualified sub. (We will make a sign up for makeup lessons so you may pick the time that works best for you.)

If there is an emergency please reach out!

MATERIALS

1. An Instrument

Some instruments are fractional sizes and should be rented so you are not stuck with a small size. Do NOT buy online or pawn until you have spoken with your teacher. Many places do not have great deals and we want to be sure you are getting a quality instrument that will take your musician to where they want to be.

2. Metronome/Tuner

We recommend the TE Tuner App (Tonal Energy) it has a metronome, tuner, and analysis function that will tell your musician how in-tune they are on a staff

3. Music (Books & MakeMusic)

These will vary based on your teacher. Our teachers at KaliKo teach as they see fit to give them to best experience.

In some cases teachers may require an online practice aid called MakeMusic which is an additional cost.
